Power Supply

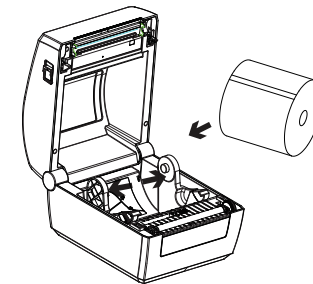
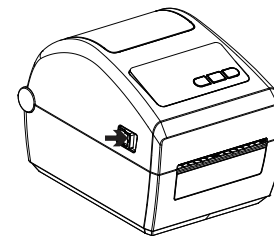
1. Make sure the printer is turned off.
2. Connect the power adapter to the printer.
3. Connect the power adapter to the power cord.
4. Plug the other side of the power cord into the socket outlet.



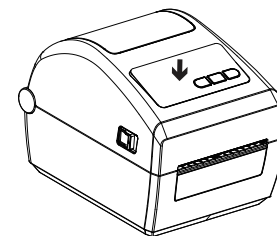
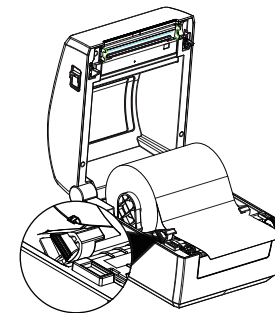
Warning:

Paper Loading

1. Press the cover opening button and lift the cover.
2. Pull the roll holders open and place the roll between them.



3. Confirm that the paper roll is tightly attached to the roll holders, and press down the locking tab.
4. Press down the cover until it snaps closed.
